### *Warami everyone! (Welcome in Darug language)*

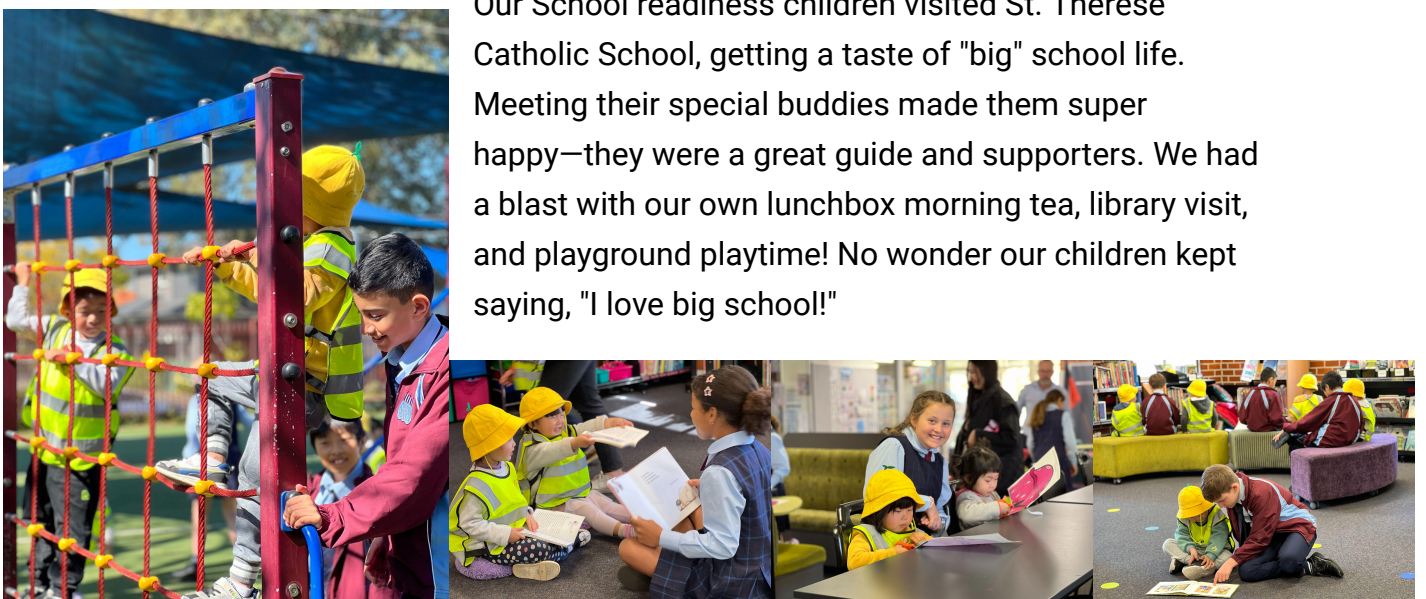

### Library visit for Book Week:

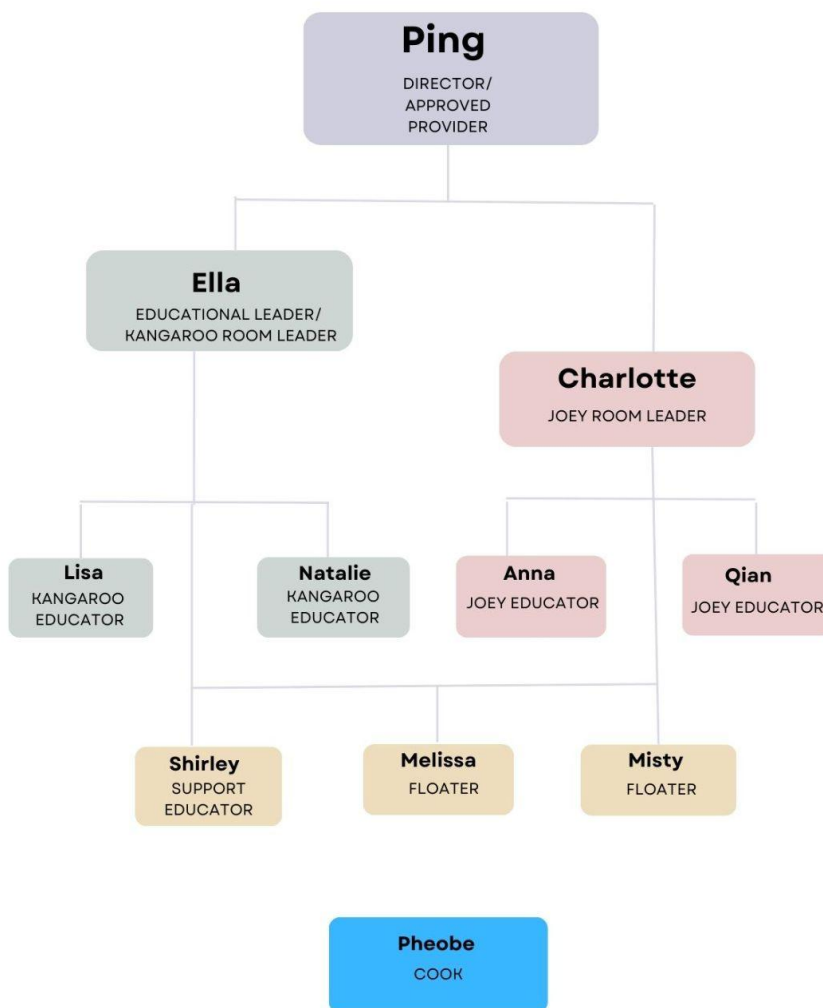
