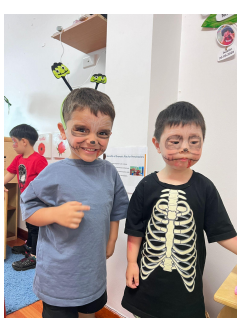
Grandparents Day:
